## Certificate III in Community Services

This qualification reflects the role of entry level community services workers who support individuals through the provision of person-centred services. Work may include day-to-day support of individuals in community settings or support the implementation of specific community-based programs.



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# Certificate III in Community Services

**Course duration:** This course will be delivered and assessed in 52 weeks.

## Eligibility:

To be eligible to enrol in the Certificate 3 Guarantee program\*, prospective students must:

- be aged 15 years or older
- be no longer at school (with exception of students in years 10, 11 and 12 undertaking VET in School (VETiS) program – see the VETiS fact sheet for more information)
- permanently reside in Queensland
- be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen
- not hold or be enrolled in, a certificate III or higher-level qualification, not including qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training.

\* The Certificate 3 Guarantee program is funded by the Queensland Government for eligible Queenslanders.

## Entry requirements:

There are no pre-requisites for entry into this course however, candidates are required to complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy Assessment at application for admission which is used to determine the level of support (if any) that may be required or adjustment needed to the training plan on enrolment.

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
